SUBJECT

Award of Bid for Anderson Treatment Plant Emergency Storage Pond No. 5

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Director recommends that the City Council:

Adopt a resolution:

1. Awarding the contract for Anderson Treatment Plant Emergency Storage Pond No. 5 to the lowest responsible bidder, Hutchins Paving & Engineering of Redding, CA in the amount of \$756,000.
2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract upon receipt of required insurance certificates and payment and performance bonds.
3. Authorizing the Public Works Director to approve additional project change orders not to exceed 10% of the contract bid amount.

FISCAL IMPACT

The engineers estimate for project construction, contingencies and construction engineering and administration is \$1,100,000 and will be paid through California Statewide Communities Development Authority Waste Water Revenue Bonds (CSCDA).

DISCUSSION and BACKGROUND

At the City Council meeting of February 17, 2009, the City Council approved the project plans and specifications and authorized bidding for the Anderson Treatment plant Emergency Storage Pond No.5 Project.

On May 27, 2009 at 2:00 pm, 9 sealed bids were received and opened. The lowest responsible bidder was Hutchins Paving and engineering of Redding, with a low bid of Seven Hundred Fifty Six Thousand (\$756,000) Dollars.

This is an important project for the City that will allow for additional emergency storage during higher than normal storm events that exceed our current 25 year event capacity. Because of the favorable bids, we will be able to use the remaining bond funds on our Cobblestone Inflow and Infiltration project currently schedule for this fall.
