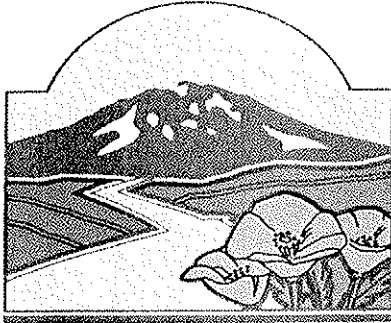

SUBJECT

Resolution calling for a General Municipal Election.

RECOMMENDATION

The City Clerk recommends the Council:

Adopt a resolution calling for a General Election on November 2, 2010, for the purpose of electing two Council members to four-year terms.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City has budgeted sufficient appropriations in the proposed 2010-2011 budget to pay the estimated \$3,200 cost for the Shasta County Elections Department to conduct the election on behalf of the City.

DISCUSSION and BACKGROUND

In order to fulfill the requirements of both the State Election Code and the State Government Code, the City Council must, by resolution, call a municipal election for November 2, 2010. Two four-year City Council seats will be up for election. These seats are currently held by Councilmembers Schaefer and Webster.

Two other important items of this resolution include the provision that the Shasta County Election Department is assigned all of the tasks of conducting this municipal election on behalf of the City and that each City Council candidate would be required to pay their own costs for the printing of any candidate statement which the candidate may wish to have included in election materials sent to voters by the Shasta County Elections Department.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-__

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON
CALLING FOR A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Anderson has the need to call a General Municipal Election to be held on November 2, 2010, for the purpose of the election of two members of the City Council, each for a term of four years; and

WHEREAS, the Shasta County Board of Supervisors has authorized the Shasta County Elections Department to conduct the election for the City of Anderson;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there shall be, and there is hereby called and ordered, held in the City of Anderson, County of Shasta, on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, a regular General Municipal Election of the qualified electors for the purpose of electing two (2) members of the City Council each for the term of four (4) years.

Section 2. That the foregoing election shall be conducted by the Shasta County Election Department on behalf of the City of Anderson.

Section 3. That each of the candidates will be required to pay the costs for the printing of his or her own candidate statement if the candidate wants such a statement to be included on the ballot.

Section 4. That the Shasta County Election Department is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

Section 5. That the City of Anderson recognizes certain costs will be incurred by the County by reason of these actions and agrees to reimburse the County for the reasonable costs incurred.

Section 6. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Election Department of the County of Shasta.

Section 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
