

## SUBJECT

Award Bid for the Anderson Bikeway.

## RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Director recommends that the City Council:

### Adopt a resolution:

1. Awarding the contract for the Anderson Bikeway to the lowest responsible bidder, Site Work Solutions, Inc. of Redding, California in the amount of Five Hundred and Forty Eight Thousand (\$548,000.00) Dollars.
2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract upon receipt of required insurance certificates and payment and performance bonds.
3. Authorizing the Public Works Director to approve additional project change orders not to exceed 15% of the contract bid amount.
4. Amending the 2010/2011 adopted budget to include \$620,000 appropriations for this project.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Total project costs are estimated to be \$776,800. In May of 2009 the Redevelopment Agency approved the use of Tax Increment Bond proceeds for the preparation of plans, engineering and environmental findings at a cost of up to \$156,800. The construction funding is from the Bicycle Transportation Account Grant (BTA) that the City received in September of 2009 for \$620,000.

## **DISCUSSION and BACKGROUND**

In the last several years, staff has discussed with the City Council the need to construct a class I and II bike lane along Highway 273 between South Street and Pleasant Hills Drive. This project will not only provide a safe passage for bicyclists and pedestrians traveling to work and shopping in the south end of town, but would significantly improve the appearance of Highway 273 along the west side. The City Council has supported this project in the past and it has been included in the five year capital improvement plan.

On May 5, 2009 the Anderson Redevelopment Agency authorized the Executive Director to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Omni Means Ltd. for the completion of the environmental documents, design, and preparation of the plans and specifications. The Agency also made findings required by the California Health and Safety Code for the Southwest Project Area tax increment funding of construction of a class I and II bike lane along Highway 273 from South Street to Pleasant Hills Drive.

In September of 2009 the City was notified by Caltrans that the Anderson Bikeway Project had been selected as a grant recipient for the Bicycle Transportation Account. The grant amount was \$620,000. The Engineer's estimate for construction including contingencies and construction engineering is \$619,819.

In addition, the project has not yet been appropriated in the 2010/2011 budget and the attached resolution amends the budget as needed to complete this project.

AWARDING THE BID FOR THE ANDERSON BIKEWAY**

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to accept the low bid from Site Work Solutions, Inc., for the Anderson Bikeway; and

WHEREAS, the low bid for the project came in below the Engineer's estimate; and

WHEREAS, the City's consulting project engineer, Omni Means Ltd., has checked the qualifications of the contractor and found they meet the contract requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Anderson does hereby:

1. Award the contract for the Anderson Bikeway to the lowest responsible bidder, Site Work Solutions, Inc. of Redding, California in the amount of Five Hundred Forty Eight Thousand (\$548,000) Dollars;
2. Authorize the City Manager to execute the contract upon receipt of required insurance certificates and payment and performance bonds; and
3. Authorize the Public Works Director to approve additional project change orders not to exceed 15% of the contract bid amount.
4. Direct the Finance Director to amend the 2010/2011 fiscal year adopted budget as follows:
