## SUBJECT

Award of Bid for Street Maintenance Project 2009-2 (FAU – Federal Stimulus) Project.

## RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Director recommends that the City Council:

**Adopt a resolution:**

1. Awarding the contract for Street Maintenance Project 2009-2 (FAU – Federal Stimulus) Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Tullis, Inc. of Redding, CA in the amount of \$377,310.40.
2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract upon receipt of required insurance certificates and payment and performance bonds.
3. Authorizing the Public Works Director to approve additional project change orders not to exceed 10% of the contract bid amount.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Construction of this project will be paid 100% from federal transportation stimulus funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009.

## **DISCUSSION and BACKGROUND**

At the City Council meeting of March 17, 2009, council approved a resolution giving "Conditional Authorization to Bid" the Street Maintenance Project 2009-2 because of pending environmental (NEPA) and Caltrans approvals. On July 07, 2009 we received our NEPA environmental clearance and Caltrans gave approval to bid our project (E-76). On July 23, 2009 we advertised the project for construction bids.

This project will construct repairs to streets designated as "Federal Aid Urban" routes including Deschutes Road from the UPRR crossing to the I-5 south bound off ramp, South Street from the city limits to Emily Drive and Rupert Road. Construction will include full depth AC repairs, asphalt overlays, utility adjustments and traffic delineation.

On August 13, 2009 at 2:00 pm, 3 sealed bids were received and opened. The lowest responsible bidder was Tullis, Inc. of Redding, California with a low bid of Three Hundred Seventy Seven Thousand, Three Hundred Ten Dollars and Forty Cents (\$377,310.40).

The contractor's references have been checked and based on favorable results, the Public Works Director recommends council approve a resolution awarding the project to Tullis, Inc. of Redding, California.
