## SUBJECT

Award of Bid for Barney Street Storm Drain Improvement Project.

## RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Director recommends that the City Council:

**Adopt a resolution:**

1. Awarding the contract for the Barney Street Storm Drain Improvement Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Bobby Martin Construction, Inc. of Redding, CA in the amount of \$87,000.
2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract upon receipt of required insurance certificates and payment and performance bonds.
3. Authorizing the Public Works Director to approve additional project change orders not to exceed 20% of the contract bid amount.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

This project is included in the 2009/2010 Drainage Capital Improvement Plan and is budgeted for \$125,000.

## **DISCUSSION and BACKGROUND**

At the City Council meeting of July 21, 2009, council gave authorization to bid the Barney Street Storm Drain Improvement Project and the project was advertised for bids on July 29<sup>th</sup> and August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

The project will construct a new 48-inch steel storm drain pipe under the railroad near Marx Way. Installation of this pipe will add much needed additional storm drain capacity to our existing system at this location, thereby enabling certain existing area detention facilities to be eliminated.

On August 26, 2009 at 3:00 pm, 3 sealed bids were received and opened and the lowest responsible bidder was Bobby Martin Construction, Inc. of Redding, CA in the amount of Eighty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$87,000.00). Although the low bid exceeds the engineers estimate of \$60,000, it still is within the 2009/2010 Drainage CIP budget of 125,000 and is a very important drainage improvement that should be constructed.

The bid documents and contractor's references have been checked and the Public Works Director would like to recommends council approve a resolution awarding the project to Bobby Martin Construction, Inc. of Redding, California.
