SUBJECT

Award of Bid for Manter Lane Lift Station Abandonment Project.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Director recommends that the City Council:

Adopt a resolution:

1. **Awarding the contract for Manter Lane Lift Station Abandonment Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Heide & Williams of Napa, CA in the amount of \$102,338.00.**
2. **Authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract upon receipt of required insurance certificates and payment and performance bonds.**
3. **Authorizing the Public Works Director to approve additional project change orders not to exceed 15% of the contract bid amount.**

FISCAL IMPACT

This project is included in the 2009/2010 Sewer Capital Improvement Plan and is budgeted for \$250,000.

DISCUSSION and BACKGROUND

At the City Council meeting of July 21, 2009, council gave authorization to bid the Manter Lane Lift Station Abandonment Project and the project was advertised for bids on August 3rd and 17th, 2009.

The project will construct a new 10 and 12 inch gravity sewer main from the existing Manter Lane lift station over to and adjacent to Hwy 273 to an existing manhole at Anderson Creek. This project is being constructed to eliminate the existing lift station that is experiencing high rates of maintenance and after hour call-outs due to clogging of the pumps. Over time, this project will save the City money by eliminating lift station maintenance and over-time due to after hour call-outs.

On August 26, 2009 at 2:00 pm, 7 sealed bids were received and opened and the lowest responsible bidder was Heide & Williams, Inc. of Napa, California with a low bid of One Hundred Two Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty Eight Dollars (\$102,338.00). This bid was considerably lower than the \$180,000 engineer's estimate and should result in a significant cost savings to the City.

The bid documents and contractor's references have been checked and the Public Works Director would like to recommend council approve a resolution awarding the project to Heide & Williams, Inc. of Napa, California.
